# **Fundraising**

For family members that are computer savvy and can print photos from CD's, you have the option of owning all the pictures that are in the photo album and more. We have created a CD with 350 of the best reunion photos. *The fundraiser price is \$15*.

#### **Reunion DVD**

We have great footage from the reunion including Dunn's River falls, Family Olympics, the Memorial Service and other priceless moments. *The fund-raiser price is* \$15.

All items will be available by e-mailing, writing, calling or placing an order in our Online Family Store. We have also enclosed an order form included in this mailing. Your orders will go a long way in helping us reach our goals. Again, funds collected will be used to offset the committees

expenses. Surpluses will be maintained in the Hibbert Family Account. Please feel free to view basic financial information as we will be posting it on the website under the fundraising link.


The family store is now under construction. We will notify
